One Century Farm Certificate will be awarded for each legal farm owner by Iowa Department of Agriculture. Additional certificates may be purchased at a cost of \$1.00 per certificate from the Iowa Department of Agriculture. Would like to purchase 6 additional certificates **

When was the present home built? PRIOR TO Wm. Krohn's purchase of the land.

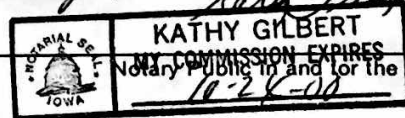
What are the farm's crops or products? Corn & Soybeans--nearly all acres are tillable.
